## **InteGrade Pro 9.2:**

### ***New Features and Enhancements to Make Grading Even Easier!***

InteGrade Pro 9.2 is a fairly major release offering new features and several important maintenance corrections.

#### **Grade Table Rounding**

Feedback indicated that InteGrade Pro's method of rounding percentages to letter grades caused some confusion. Setup->Grading Rules, Grade Tables has been modified to make this easier to understand.

#### **New Multiclass Report Option**

In response to user requests, InteGrade Pro can now include fewer spreadsheets in a multiclass report. This feature is based on spreadsheets having an associated date range, which is not imported; you'll need to use Setup->Spreadsheets to assign date ranges to your numeric and skill spreadsheets before you use this feature.

#### **BCC Progress Reports**

In response to user requests, InteGrade Pro can now optionally BCC ("blind carbon copy") emailed reports to your email address. This will generate a lot of email in your inbox, but will give you an *exact* record of what went out when, and to whom.

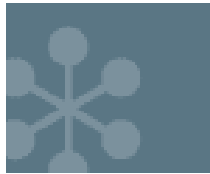
#### **Inactive Students**

A few changes have been made to improve the display of inactive students (i.e. students who have been removed from a class, usually by your school's administration system).

- Instead of prefixing a ~ to the name, the student's information will be struck out.
- In addition, in the main viewer area, the student's information will appear in a different color, and his or her name will appear in parentheses.
- You can now turn inactive student display on and off from the main viewer.
- You can now change where inactive students sort relative to active students in Setup->Display on the Spreadsheet tab.

#### **Personal Notes**

InteGrade Pro 9.2 introduces Personal Notes. Unlike normal notes, personal notes will not appear on reports and will not be exported. To make a paragraph in a note a personal note, start the paragraph with two dollar signs (\$\$). The paragraph will not appear on reports, and will not be exported.



## Bonus Scores

InteGrade Pro 9.2 includes various tweaks designed to make bonus tasks easier to understand:

- The Empty Scores option for missing tasks no longer includes empty scores on bonus tasks. A blank score indicates something different for a bonus task ("no bonus") than a regular task ("not entered yet"). The other options still affect bonus tasks.
- Viewing a bonus task as a letter grade will now produce a letter grade of n/a, rather than displaying a letter grade from the table. This fix affects areas missed by the fix in 9.1.2 (which only addressed certain reports and certain types of bonus tasks).

## Various Corrections

InteGrade Pro 9.2 also includes a variety of corrections:

- Previous versions of InteGrade Pro could not scan scores for students with very long student numbers. This has been corrected.
- Previous versions of InteGrade Pro had a security hole allowing gradebooks to be opened despite password protection on Windows. This exploit has been closed; update all gradebooks to 9.2 to secure them.
- Previous versions of InteGrade Pro could display an error when pasting very long (nonsense) words into a notes area. This has been corrected.
- The progress bar that appears when opening gradebooks now takes into account the auto-update process, removing the impression that InteGrade Pro has hung.
- The speed of import (including auto-update) has been improved, especially for large gradebooks.
- More improvements to client/server stability.
