

Chippewa Valley Schools Athletic Fee Program

The established Athletic Fees for the 2007-2008 school year :
\$100 for Middle School Athletes | \$125 for High School Athletes

The following information pertains to the Athletic Fee Program:

1. Payment will be accepted by any of the following methods:
 - a. On the first day after the team has been selected, payment must then be made to the Coach at each HS or MS, this must occur by the first contest. Please fill out the Athletic Fee Application, attach a check or money order made payable to Chippewa Valley Schools and submit to the COACH prior to participating in the first contest - **Cash will not be accepted.**
2. Payments can be made by check or money order only. **No cash will be accepted.** Make checks payable to Chippewa Valley Schools. Your cancelled check will serve as your receipt. A \$10 fee will be assessed for any check returned by the bank as non-collectable.
3. Students applying for financial assistance must see their building athletic administrator for application procedures. Assistance is determined solely upon eligibility for the free and reduced lunch program.
4. Paying the Athletic Fee does not guarantee playing time beyond what is specified in the Athletic Code of Conduct. Paying the Athletic Fee does not change the control over any conditions of the team.
5. Fees are not refundable. Voluntary withdrawal or lack of playing time will not be the basis for refunding fees.
 - a. The fee will not be refunded or pro-rated for an athlete who is ineligible or becomes ineligible during the season.
 - b. The fee will not be refunded or pro-rated when an athlete is removed from a team for disciplinary reasons.
 - c. The fee will not be refunded or pro-rated when cancelled contests cannot be rescheduled, when a full allotment of games cannot be scheduled, or because the number of scheduled contests varies from level to level or from school to school.
6. Athletes who experience a documented season-ending injury will receive a pro-rated refund after making application to the athletic administrator at your school.
7. Athletes are required to have a valid physical on file in the Athletic Office before taking part in tryouts or practice. The physical must be signed and dated April 15, 2007 or later.
8. Paying the Athletic Fee does not alter the policies of the Chippewa Valley Board of Education, the Student Code of Conduct, the Athletic Code of Conduct, or the regulations of the Michigan High School Athletic Association, and individual team rules.
